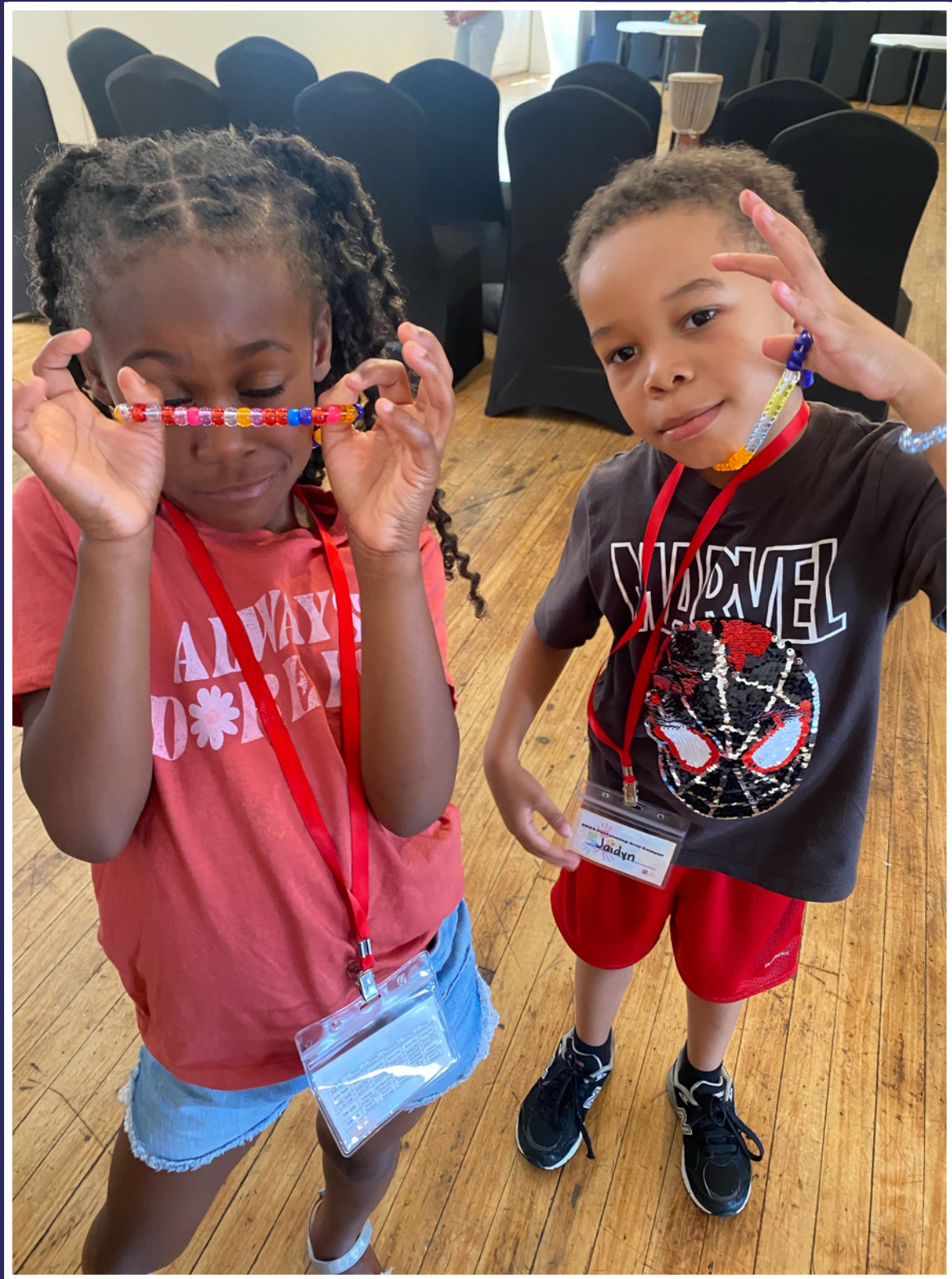

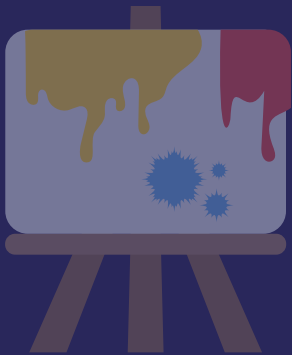


REGISTER TODAY!
