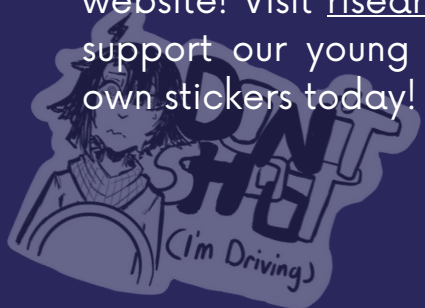
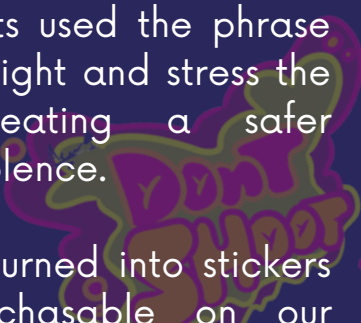
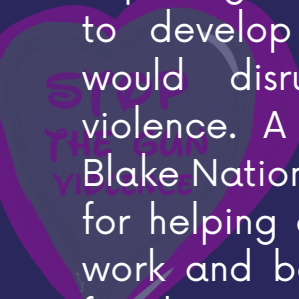
# WE MADE IT BIG
